

## Ramblings from the Rectory

This Christmas, in common with churches up and down the country, our congregations at Wilton and Netherhampton will be swelled by many who worship with us only occasionally - visitors staying with family or friends, and many who come just to "re-connect" with the traditions and "story" of Christmas.

And, it seems, no matter how certain or sceptical our beliefs may be, there is an enduring power in this story of the Christ-child the story of the God who loved (and loves) his creation so much that he chose to become part of it; to bring new meaning to a world of senseless violence and greed; to bring fresh direction to a world confused by power struggles and competing visions of the future; to bring about the regeneration of the world, not by the spectacular antics of some "Marvel Superhero", but by the gradual transformation of individual hearts and minds. from suspicion and distrust of others to understanding and acceptance, from fatalistic despair to trust in the ultimate goodness of God's purposes, from the darkness of deception to the light of truth.

In many ways this seems as much a story for our times as it was for those who encountered Jesus in the flesh, 2000 years ago.

I invite you, then, to come and engage with this story again during our Christmas celebrations. Perhaps join us for one of our Carol Services - to hear the story afresh, in words and music; perhaps the simplicity of our Christingle service on the afternoon of Christmas Eve (suitable for young and old alike); or soak up the "atmosphere" of beauty and holiness at Midnight Mass -as Christmas Eve turns to Christmas Day.

However you choose to do so, you are welcome to come and explore the message of Christmas with us.





### 2020 Vision!



#### 2020 marks the 175th anniversary of our Parish Church!

During the year there will be a variety of celebrations, including a large number of concerts - featuring local music groups, such as the Salisbury Chamber Choir; returning favourites, such as the Cambridge Renaissance Voices; rising young professionals, including "The Haydn Collective"; Salisbury Festival Events and many more! Details to follow...

It will also provide a useful "springboard" for our thoughts as we consider how the building can best meet the needs of worshippers, the wider community and its many visitors today.



And so, a little history! Known formally as The Parish Church of St. Mary and St. Nicholas, Wilton - and informally as the "Italianate Church" - the building was designed in the Romanesque style, derived from Tuscany.

The inspiration and funding came from the Hon. Sidney Herbert and his mother, Ekaterina Woronzow, Dowager Countess of Pembroke. The church reflects their eclectic tastes and contains many fine, salvaged pieces from across Europe.

Built between 1841 and 1845, the architects were T. H. Wyatt and D. Brandon. Even now, it is an unusual building for an English market town - even more so in 1845! Recognised as a "Major Parish Church", due to its historic and architectural significance, it is attracting an increasing number of tourists to our town.

The mosaics, among the most striking features, were in fact later additions - added between 1908 and 1946 by Gertrude Martin, whose work can also be seen in Westminster RC Cathedral and the Houses of Parliament!.
