Welcome to our 1st edition of 2020 - our Parish Church's 175th Year!

In this edition you will find details of events coming up soon including some excellent concerts in our Parish Church.

There are details of special services, including those on Mothering Sunday, at Easter and our Service of Commemoration, held this year at the end of April...

At the beginning of March we will have begun the season of Lent, with **Palm Sunday** beginning Holy Week on **5th April**, and **Easter Sunday** on **12th April**.

The early May Bank Holiday is Friday 8th this year, and there will be special displays in church over the weekend leading into Wilton's first Plant Festival (10 –16 May).

April/ May should also see the long-awaited renovation of our **Church Rooms**. Hopefully more news in the summer edition!

At the end of May we mark the third of the Church's major Festival **Pentecost ("Whit Sunday")** on **Sunday 31st May -** recalling Jesus' disciples being empowered by God's Holy Spirit, and praying that we may be equipped by the Spirit for the tasks God asks of us.


