Church Services

Although it's still not entirely clear what our worship is going to look and feel like over the coming months, we are slowly increasing the number of services we offer each week.

At **St Catherine's Netherhampton**, there is now a regular service of "Evening Prayer", on the first Sunday of each month at 5pm. We are also gradually re-introducing Morning Services there.

At the **Parish Church** (St Mary and St Nicholas', Wilton) there is a short **Holy Communion** Service on **Wednesdays at 10am**, and on **Sundays** there is always a service at **10.45am**. This is a short (30 min.) service of '**Morning Prayer'**, sometimes followed by Holy Communion for those who wish to stay.

On **some Sundays** there will also be a service of Holy Communion at **8am**.

St. Peter's, Fugglestone, is not currently open for regular worship, but we hope to give the church a good "spring "clean, so that we are able to celebrate St Peter's Day on the afternoon of 27 June.


